

Who is eligible to attend?

If you think you or your loved-one may want to come to The Friends Centre, contact us for a free trial day. We will arrange your transport and lunch for the day. If you have already been assessed by Health and Social Care as needing support and financially be below their threshold, you may qualify for your placement to be paid by them. If not, you can pay privately at a rate of £49.44 a day, including all your food, drinks and transport.
